

Red Pine Leadership Camp

Leadership development for youth, grades 7-11

RPLC is a one week overnight camp for youth entering grades 7-11 with a focus on leadership training. Campers sleep in cabins with carefully selected cabin counselors and are provided with healthy meals and days packed full of leadership development, camp wide games, interest groups, evening activities, swimming, water activities and general camp fun.



Leadership training includes a host of interactive activities that integrate communication, conflict resolution, team building, diversity, self-discovery and more. We incorporate a low ropes course into the program and provide engaging leadership experiences through which to learn these important skills.

New for 2017 we will be offering a CIT program for youth entering grade 11 or students who will be 16 years old at the time of camp. This program will expand on prior leadership knowledge and build a solid understanding of what it means to be a counsellor and lead others in a position of responsibility.

RPLC is hosted on the property of Red Pine Camp; a well-established family camp located an hour and a half west of Ottawa on beautiful Golden Lake and is accredited by the Ontario Camps Association. Camp takes place the week before Labour Day; from Sunday, August 27 to Friday, September 1, 2017.
